Mayor Smith reported that he had spoken with Attorneys Skidmore Garrett and Baley Allred IV to clarify their proposals for the position of City Attorney. In the recessed session last week, there had been question concerning the number of hours each would provide in return for their retainer fee.

Mr. Garrett, who was currently serving as City Attorney, submitted a proposal to represent the City for \$1,000 per month, which would include attendance at all meetings, with a \$200 per hour fee for any services provided outside the meetings.

Mr. Allred had proposed to represent the City for a retainer of \$1,200 per month, which included 12 hours per month, including time of meetings, with any additional time required over and above the 12 hours to be billed at \$200 per hour.

Following a brief discussion, on a motion by Ed Brady, seconded by Charles Cooper, the Board unanimously voted to accept Attorney Baley Allred, IV's proposal for City Attorney.

On a motion by Danny Hayes, seconded by Corwin Brown, the Board unanimously voted to accept the bid from Deep South Fire Trucks for a new 1,000 gallon fire truck in the amount of \$225,130, which will be paid for by a Federal Disaster Grant.

It was noted that three other bids had been received for the fire truck, but they were disqualified because they did not meet bid specifications.

It was announced that the November meeting will be on Tuesday, November 12, since Monday, November 11 is Veterans Day.

With no further business, on a motion by Gene Holt, seconded by Danny Hayes, the Board voted to adjourn.
